

## Program Content and Format

What legally constitutes child abuse and neglect? When do your obligations shift from providing direct care to also involving legal assistance to assure the welfare of a child? In what ways are you liable for your actions — or for your failure to act? How do you act with both professional and legal propriety? How do you conduct yourself if you testify in court about a case of child abuse or neglect?

This course was developed by the multidisciplinary Child Protection Team of the University of Michigan Hospitals to answer these questions for professionals who work with children. It is designed to familiarize the participant with the laws which affect children and those that govern child abuse and neglect. Participants learn how to integrate these legal requirements and procedures into their clinical practice with children and families. The course also provides a legal and procedural framework to deal with child abuse and neglect through interdisciplinary practice.
